1. Review table of past recommendations

Document is available on Box. After reviewing this history, it was suggested that we give more specific guidelines to SWATeams about iWG's expectations for the recommendations, and consider ways to improve reciprocal discussion between SWATeams and iWG.

2. Discuss Econs004, Green Labs Coordinator recommendation

We currently have no permanent programming for green labs coordination. Perhaps facilities managers should be in charge of sustainable initiatives, but they are not, and researchers can react poorly to facility managers or F&S giving them direction.

Need to think carefully about where this person should be housed, as they will be the face of the green labs program and must be seen as having some sort of authority.

We have 1700 fume hoods and expect that 20% of them, or 340, could be decommissioned. The annual savings from closing merely 20 in a year could pay the salary of the coordinator (could save \$60,000-100,000 per year).

Actual description of what the responsibilities are is necessary.

OVCR would probably be best place to do this. Should be a top-driven role. Big picture of upcoming budget cuts and reallocations should be considered.

Decided to converge on a formal recommendation to send to the OVCR and see what they say.

3. Review other incoming recommendations

From Transportation: Include covered bike parking in parking decks.

From Water: Install permanent greywater meters at BIF, build greywater lines into design center, and increase cycles of concentration at cooling towers.

Will discuss more in depth at next meeting; in the meantime, please read these recommendations carefully.
